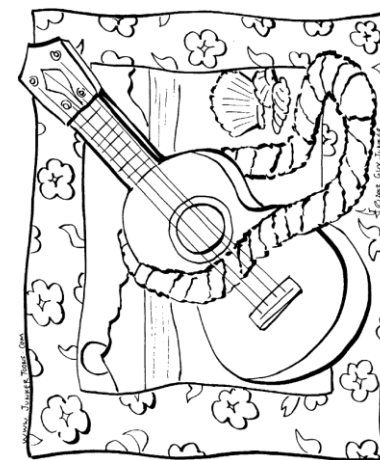
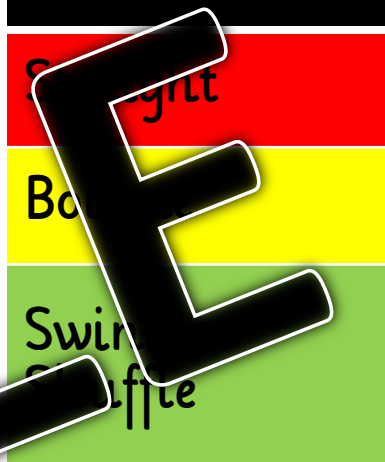
### Pattern 4

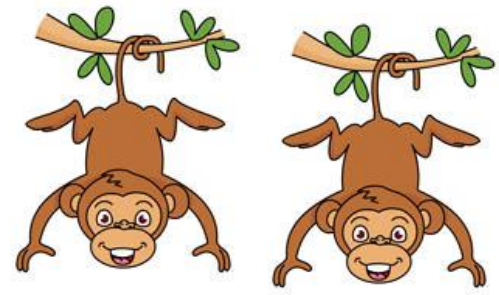
